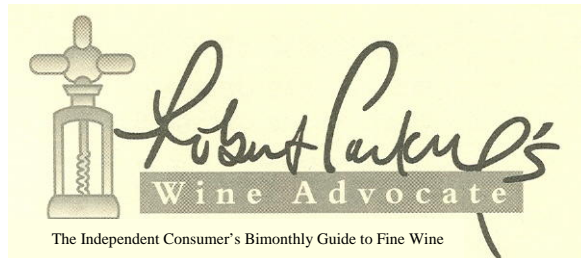

Bodegas Rafael Cambra is a relatively new estate with its first vintage in 2001.

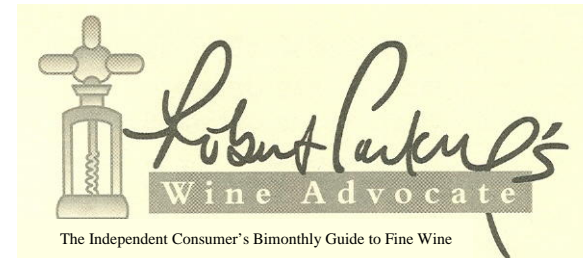
