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## Pedro Romero Cream Sherry Full Sweet

Henna / dark copper color with perfect clarity. In the opening nose after the pour, I'm disappointed by the lack of aromatic animation; further time in the glass barely stimulates distant scents of prunes and cocoa; pass over this anemic bouquet and proceed directly to tasting. Entry is relatively light for a cream, but that's a plus as the taste profile leans more towards the black raisins and plums; midpalate retains the lighter-than-normal approach as the acidity balances well with the ripe fruitiness. Finishes well in a plummy / blackberry manner that works. Would have scored higher if there was more bouquet. June, 2009

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
