Tarnished silver color; as clean and clear as one could possibly hope for. Alluring smells of baker's yeast and sourdough bread in the opening inhalations; seven more minutes of aeration stimulate delightfully tart / acidic / astringent notes of sour apple and bread dough, with background scents of carnations; I like this bouquet a lot. Entry is very sour and like unripened yellow fruit; midpalate borders on being too extreme in its sourness (and might be for some fino lovers), but the overall flavor profile certainly contains more than ample charm and earthiness to make it recommendable.
